



Semi Permanent Make-Up (Micro Pigmentation)

Inter dermal pigmentation is a revolutionary method of applying micro-insertions of natural pigments into the dermal layer of the skin. This state of the art technique is medically proven and completely safe. It can be used for a variety of permanent cosmetic enhancements such as permanent eyebrows and eyeliner and lip liner/colour. Other permanent cosmetic procedures include the treatment of vitiligo, stretch marks, scar camouflage, areola restoration, hairline enhancement, birthmarks, freckles and age spots.

Who benefits from Inter dermal cosmetics?

- Men and Women
- Busy people with little time to apply make-up
- Those with allergies to conventional make-up
- Anyone who desires freedom and convenience from daily make-up application
- Those who are physically incapable of applying make-up
- Athletic people and those with oily skin who tend to shed make-up easily
- Burn survivors and individuals with flaws in their skin
- Men and women who seek correction of asymmetrical facial features
- Men and Women who wish to look their best at all times

Is the procedure painful?

Topical anaesthetics are used to minimize discomfort.

Do I have a choice of colours?

Definitely! There is a wide spectrum of colours from which you may choose.

Do I have a choice in the placement of pigments?

Of course. You will be fully aware during the procedure, advising the technician where you wish the implants to be located.

What is involved in the recovery?

There will be slight swelling and redness in the skin that will subside quickly. You may

resume normal activities immediately after the procedure. Complete healing takes one to six weeks while the pigmentation matures and develops its final colour. A consultation and patch test are required forty eight hours prior to treatment.

Top up sessions are required to achieve optimum results one year after your original procedure.

Permanent cosmetic make-up pre-procedure information

All permanent cosmetic procedures are multi-session processes. You are required to come back for at least one touch-up visit before it can be determined that your work is complete. Touch-up visits are scheduled at 4-week intervals or longer.

Be prepared for the colour intensity of your procedure to be significantly sharper, brighter, or darker than what is expected for the final outcome. It will take time for this transition, based upon how quickly the outer layer of your skin exfoliates.

While these injected tones may initially simulate the exact colour and tone desired, it will not always remain a perfect match. Injected tones are constant, while your own tones will vary depending on exposure to cold, heat, sun and circulatory changes. For example, if you tan your skin and had a scar camouflaged, your surrounding skin will be darker in appearance than the treated area.

1. Since delicate skin or sensitive areas may swell slightly or redden, some clients feel it best not to make any social plans for a day or two following any procedure.
2. Wear your normal make-up and bring your lip or brow pencils to the office on the day of the procedure.
3. Any tweezing or waxing should be done at least 48 hours prior to the procedure; electrolysis no less than five days before. Do not resume any method of hair removal for at least two weeks.
4. Any eyelash or eyebrow tinting or eyelash curling should be done no sooner than 48 hours before or 2 weeks after the procedure.
5. Do not wear contact lenses during or immediately following the eyeliner procedure. Remember to bring your glasses. You may resume wearing your contact lenses as soon as your eyes return to their pre-tattooed condition.
6. If you are having lip procedures and have any history of cold sores/fever blisters/herpes simplex, you will be required to contact your doctor to obtain the proper prescription to prevent such outbreaks.
7. Refrain from the use of alcohol, aspirin, aspirin-containing medications, ibuprofen, or coumadin for 7 days before and 2 days after any procedure. Refrain from judgement-altering drugs for at least 24 hours prior to any procedure. **No medication should be discontinued without first consulting your doctor.**
8. A patch-test is offered upon request.

Permanent cosmetic make-up after care instructions

Proper care following your procedure is necessary to achieve the best results. Keep in mind that in many cases, some unevenness of colour is to be expected. This is the purpose of the touch-up visit. Please review the following directions and refer to them as necessary. If during your healing process you have any questions or concerns, please

contact your technician.

1. Ice packs protected with a cloth may be applied as necessary to reduce swelling. Sleeping slightly elevated helps alleviate swelling sometimes seen the morning after facial procedures.
2. Wash your hands before touching any treated area. Cotton-tipped applicators may be used to gently cleanse the eye area. Do not expose the area to dirty or unsanitary conditions. Wearing glasses outdoors is a good way to protect new eyeliner from dust, etc.
3. Some itching is normal. **DO NOT PICK, PEEL, OR SCRATCH** the treated area or your colour may heal unevenly and you risk scarring and infection.
4. No make-up is to be applied for 72 hours after the procedure. After any eyeliner procedure, use new mascara. Do not use an eyelash curler for two weeks.
5. Do not expose your healing skin to direct sun, tanning beds, hot tubs, (tub baths if body area is treated), saunas, salt water, chlorinated pools, direct shower spray, hot water, skin creams, ointments or lotions, other than what you have been instructed to use for 2 weeks following your procedure.
6. After a lip procedure, keep your lips moist at all times. Avoid spicy, salty food or heat. If using herpes medication, continue as prescribed.

Long term care

1. Use a good sunscreen daily – even the lips require protection. Sun exposure will fade your permanent cosmetics and may cause irritation even years later.
2. If you are planning a chemical peel, MRI, or other medical procedure, please inform your doctor of your cosmetic tattoo.
3. If you donate blood, it is a National Blood Service policy that you must wait one year after any tattooing procedure.
